Tuition and Fee Policy

Effective for the 2026–2027 school year. Rates are set annually and adopted by the High Rockies Community School Board of Directors. This schedule is the authoritative source for preschool tuition; the Preschool Operations Manual and Family Handbook reference it rather than restating the figures.

15-hour UPK (eligible 4-year-olds)	\$620.78/mo	\$108.89/mo

30-hour UPK does not apply to part-time schedules.

How UPK Is Applied

- Colorado’s Universal Preschool (UPK) program funds preschool hours for eligible children. Most 4-year-olds qualify for 15 hours; children who meet a qualifying factor may qualify for 30 hours.
- “State Covers” is the portion paid by UPK on the family’s behalf. “Your Cost” is the family’s remaining monthly balance after UPK is applied.
- UPK eligibility and match rates are set by the state and confirmed through each family’s UPK application. Families should complete the UPK application to receive funded hours.
